

K.I.N.D.I. Leader's Guide for Parent Meeting

Before the meeting:

- Call to invite local fire/law enforcement to attend with their child and family safety information programs.
- Line up online video to use at the meeting (crayons for children)
- Send out parent invitations (see master)
- Make copies of Safety Tips, Small Group Discussion Questions, and any other pages you need (parent comment sheets, etc.)

The meeting:

- 5 min. Welcome everyone - introduce guests, parents introduce themselves
 - 5 min. Introduce topic using the opening on previous page
 - 5 min. Administer pre-test to parents orally - discuss
 - 10 min. Children act out the Kindi Story as leader reads it -
parents say no, no, no when red flag appears
 - 5 min. Children sing K.I.N.D.I. songs
 - 5 min. One child explains Faces activity sheet (stress that anyone
can be bad - it's not who they are, it's what they do)
 - 5 min. Another child explains Places activity sheet (stress that anyplace
can be safe or unsafe - it's not the place, it's what can happen
there that makes it safe or unsafe based on circumstances)
 - 5 min. Another child explains Lost/Find Poster
 - 10 min. Break
 - 10 min. Show KinderVision® Child Safety Video Online
 - 10 min. Divide into several small discussion groups of parents with their
own children - give each child a KinderVision® activity page to color
Give Group Discussion Questions Sheet to each group
 - 10 min. Have groups report back to large group - discuss answers - thank them
for coming - remind them to reinforce tips on the Kindi Says Safety
Tips sheet (give one to each family) and display them for review
Inform parents of The Greatest Save safety quiz to review the
information covered and learn additional information about personal safety
 - 5 min. Have parents write a comment on the Parent Comment Sheet as
they leave to use as evaluation and feedback for next year's meeting
- Optional: invited fire/law enforcement guests speak
